The first round of comments within the workstream will finish on September 30th, 2018. Additionally, the workstream has recorded relevant interviews, which will serve as awareness-raising material on the tool for the SAI community, and are expected to be launched by the last quarter of 2018.</li> <li>2. The workstream members agreed upon enriching and harmonizing the workshop materials in different languages, in order to include the latest developments that have taken place in INTOSAI Regional Organizations. This updating process is expected to be concluded by the 2019 INCOSAI.</p> <p>4. A study on the impact of the IntoSAINT workshops was carried out in AFROSAI-E, and a survey to follow up the self-assessments will be launched in OLACEFS during the last third of 2018.</p>
