Mitigating action:</i> (a) Consider alternative terminology. (b) Continuously inform about focus of workstream.</li> <li><i>Project group unable to meet high expectations. Mitigating action:</i> (a) Agree on and communicate achievable goals. (b) Engage others (inside and outside INTOSAI) in a dialogue and cooperation.</li> <li><i>SAls in fragile situations unable/unwilling to contribute to the work. Mitigating action:</i> (a) SAls with relevant experience in the working group. (b) Start by demonstrating the relevance/usefulness of the work little by little.</li> <li><i>SAls in fragile situations unable to make use of what is developed. Mitigating action:</i> (a) Technical and resource limitations taken into consideration. (b) Encourage users to propose solutions.</li> </ul>
