## Work Plan Work stream on Audit of Donor Funds

The CBC Works stream on the Audit of Donor Funds (AoDF) was established in September 2021. It will work in accordance with the Terms of Reference that were approved by the CBC Steering Committee, and that states that a work plan will be developed in order to operationalize the purpose of the work stream. The Work plan presents the planned activities for the period Nov 2021-Dec 2022, and indicates when, by whom and the expected output of each activity.

## Intervention logic

#### Input

- In-kind contributions by SNAO (chair) and other SAIs, donors etc.

#### Activity

- Mapping ongoing processes and material on audit of donor funds
- Identifying/engaging with stakeholders and SAIs interested in contributing
- Sharing of experience and good practice
- Advocacy targeting donors and SAIs
- Producing information material

#### Output

- Leaflet with checklist for SAIs and donors what to consider before engaging, benefits and risks.
- Background briefing paper for donors
- SAIs and donors are aware of different aspects of engaging in audit of donor funds – including potential risks

#### **Outcome**

SAIs and donors apply good practices and make informed choices when engaging in the audit of donor funds, while safeguarding SAIs' independence and respecting their national mandate.

- Independent, effective, and competent SAIs
- Efficient use of public resources
- Donor funds being audited and used in a transparent and efficient manner
