CBC Budget for the period July 2023 to June 2024

Submitted for approval by the 2023 CBC Steering Committee

Annually the CBC Steering Committee approves the allocation of non-earmarked external CBC-funding received from INTOSAI. The CBC funds available for allocation to workstream activities during July 2023 to June 2024 amounts to EUR 55 383 – this amount is made up of current CBC reserves and unspent funds of EUR 32 883, plus the 2023 annual INTOSAI transfer to the CBC estimated at EUR 22 500 (expected to be received from the General Secretariat in July 2023).

The proposed allocations to CBC workstreams for 2023-24 set out below are based on detailed submissions made by the workstreams based on their workplans. However, is should be noted that owing to limited CBC funds, the allocations to most of the workstreams had to be reduced compared to funding requests submitted. As in prior years, the budget includes an allocation for CBC reserves for contingency purposes.
