GLOBALFLYER SURVEY 2023

Survey findings underscore the significance of peer reviews in enhancing audit practices and highlight areas for potential improvement and collaboration within the INTOSAI community

The results of the Survey will contribute to the amendments of the Subcommittee on Peer Reviews' strategy for the forthcoming period, however as the participation in the Survey was 15% a **call for greater participation** of INTOSAI members is vital for more accurate results on peer review issues.

Survey confirmed improvements in SAIs strategic planning, audit methodology, and internal processes.

To continue with these improvements our next steps may include:

1. Improving Subcommittee on Peer Reviews' web page design and usability.
2. Encouraging the use of self-assessment tools like SAI PMF before peer reviews.
3. Preparation of clearer guidance and support, addressing concerns about cost and time.
4. Facilitation of matchmaking through structured platforms and regional programs.
5. Promotion of sharing of practical insights and experiences among SAIs.
6. Expanding the Pool of Peer Experts to improve review quality.
