APPENDIX- CBC EVALUATION – DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Recommendation 1: discussion questions

- I. Discuss feasible ways in which to facilitate interactive strategic discussions during CBC Steering Committee meetings.
- II. Provide 1 or 2 examples of topics you regard as suitable for strategic CBC Steering Committee discussions.
- III. Do members support the proposal for at least two Steering Committee meetings per year, with the option to convene more if necessary?

Recommendation 2: discussion questions

- I. Looking ahead, and considering the CBC's role and mandate, where should we focus our efforts more intentionally?
- II. What principles or considerations should guide us as the CBC when determining our future strategic priorities and areas of focus?
- III. Would members support the establishment of a small task team or strategic planning group to further develop the proposed CBC strategic plan and bring a draft back to the Steering Committee for consideration?

Recommendation 3: discussion questions

- I. What should be the key considerations when deciding whether a CBC working body should continue beyond a strategic planning cycle such as INCOSAI 2028?
- II. Do the proposed distinctions between subcommittees and task forces appropriately reflect the nature and purpose of the CBC's current working bodies?
