- II. How can the CBC strengthen its focus on results and outcomes while ensuring that reporting remains practical, proportionate, and useful to working bodies and contributors?

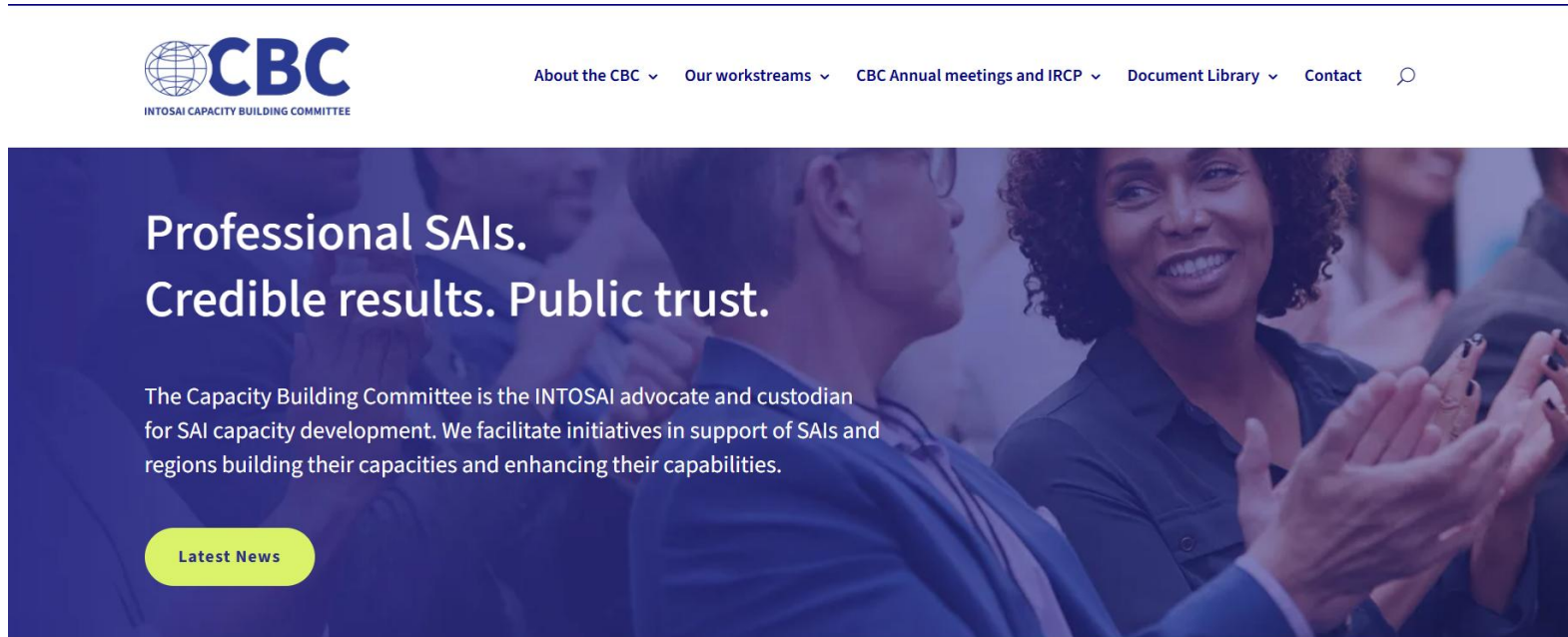
